A legend in Western New York auto racing, Charles Ronald "Ron" Lux won on dirt and asphalt. He was a versatile driver who raced USAC sprint cars, dirt modifieds and supermodifieds. In 1965, Lux won the Oswego Speedway Supermodified Championship, winning five straight features and a total of 12 for the season. Ron won the Orange County Eastern States 100 dirt Modified race in 1965. He also set fast time for the first asphalt Langhorne National Open modified (Race of Champions) event in 1965. He died in a USAC sprinter at Tulsa, OK in 1966 at the age of 26.
